6. Relate nursing management for structural and metabolic oncologic emergencies.
7. Discuss the use of genetics in cancer treatment.
8. Describe nursing interventions for the patient with GYN cancer.
9. Discuss nursing interventions for the adult patient with acute leukemia and non Hodgkin's Lymphoma.
10. Explain the nursing management for the patient with prostate, lung, and head and neck cancer.
11. Explain the nursing management for the patient with breast, colon and skin cancer.
12. Explain the coping techniques used by patients with cancer.
13. Describe the components of a patient education program for the oncology patient.
14. Name two effective test-taking strategies.
